

Guidelines during the Washington, D.C. field trip for the use of:

Cell Phones

- Can students take cell phones? YES with a parent permission form and a registration of the cell number.
 - The answer is yes but we do ask that all cell phones be used only at specific times by students for calls home to their parents.
 - There must not be any misuse of the cell phone including using it to take pictures of other students at inappropriate times.
 - Students may bring a cell phone, but should limit the calls. The phone must be turned off when directed to do so by the tour guide or chaperones, and cannot be used to disturb other students.
 - Cell phones are the responsibility of the student. The school is not responsible for the misuse or loss of cell phones.
 - Failure to follow these guidelines will result in the phone being held by the chaperone for the remainder of the trip and additional school consequences.
 - Beware of data plans! – Not all areas will offer FREE WIFI. Cell phones companies charge a lot for data overages – it is much better to buy extra data ahead of time.
